Ultimate length precision

Intelligent, sterile filling machines use stainless steel roller chains with special attachments: These not only ensure that cups and trays are positioned under the dosing mechanism with pinpoint accuracy, but also guarantee safe and hygienic conveyance of the cups and trays through the infeed, sterilisation and sealing stations, quality control and final packaging.

Accurate parallel running coupled with extreme length precision of the stainless steel chains are crucial for optimum positioning accuracy of cups and trays in the production process. At the same time, we placed special emphasis on increased service life during development. The result is precise and reliable stainless steel chains, optionally available with initial lubrication that has been tested and approved for use with food applications by the NSF.


As an option, the bent attachment plates can have a **10-mm hole.** iwis offers a range of high-performance lubricants.














CF stainless steel chains

Corrosion-free chains at their best! Precision-manufactured individual parts counteract material-related constraints and ensure outstanding positioning accuracy, reliability and wear reduction.

Specially selected chromium steels ensure that the CF stainless steel chains have the best possible level of anti-corrosion protection Alongside humidity, CF chains can also withstand **acids**, **alkalis** and even**extreme temperatures** from -80 °C to +400 °C! Stainless steel chains are at no risk from coating particles released through abrasion and are ideal **for sensitive applications** and **applications with high hygiene requirements**.

CF-b.dry stainless steel chains

The **maintenance-free**, high-alloy chromium steel roller chains can be used **absolutely dry**. This is made possible by the special, high-performance polymer b.dry friction bearing in the chain link. This friction partner avoids steel-on-steel contact between the pin and bush. This means that you can use the chain without any lubricants throughout its entire service life. A ball-drilled steel carrier bush surrounds the friction bearing, giving the chain additional strength.

Applications

- Wherever relubrication is either undesirable or impossible
- In corrosive environments
- For use in sensitive and hygiene-critical applications (food processing)
- CF-b.dry chains are resistant to aggressive substances and can be used in temperatures ranging between -100 °C and +200 °C
- External factors, such as the temperature range or contact with chemical substances, etc., have a direct impact on the performance of mechanical elements.


Engineering

Elongation

Greater productivity and higher output rates have led to regular preventive maintenance on production equipment becoming a rarity. Which makes it all the more important to be able to rely on the durability and reliability of drive chains and conveyor chains.

We use a special pre-stretching process to reduce the initial runin elongation in order to allow simple, fast and accurate fitting of the chains. We optimize wear elongation by a combination of ideal material pairings, high manufacturing precision and maintenance-free components.

Our maintenance-free roller chains also prevent corrosion and stiffening.



Operating time [h]


Positioning / Accuracy

Filling machines require the use of roller chains with strict length tolerances: The high-precision parallel operation of a pair of chains ensures exact positioning of the attachments in relation to each other.

In this regard, DIN ISO 606 defines that chains must be manufactured within a tolerance of **+0 to +0.15** % in respect of the nominal length at a defined measuring force and length. For a 5 m standard length, this means possible length discrepancies of up to 7.5 mm.

Using a special manufacturing process, we can reduce this tolerance in our JWIS stainless steel chains even further, down to **0.075** % **of the nominal length**, and thus achieve the highest possible precision in a roller chain.

With two parallel chain strands, we can also achieve parallel running accuracy of **up to 0.5 mm** — regardless of the total length — and thus ensure precise positioning.





Chain lubrication

Because most of the friction is generated in the chain link joints, lubrication of this location has a decisive impact on the service life of a chain drive. In filling machines, the use of food-grade lubricants depends on factors such as the accessibility of plant equipment, maintenance intervals, the risk of contamination and the intensity of cleaning. When selecting the correct lubricant, it is also important to consider the media with which the chain comes into contact in the application.

Residue from milk products and cleaning agents can penetrate the chain link joint, and this can take lubricant from the chain and/or have an abrasive effect. This can result in inefficient relubrication and stiffness in the chain link joints. In this type of application, JWIS CF stainless steel chains can receive an initial lubrication with iwiDUR high-performance wax, for instance.

Depending on the conditions of use, we recommend the following **lubricants**:

Initial lubricant iwidur®

New generation wax lubricant for the food industry with NSF H1 approval

iwiDUR (EL-6) is a lubricating wax for chains. It is introduced into the chain link in a special warm submersion process at iwis. This product has been specially developed for initial lubrication of chains. it offers excellent wear protection and good corrosion resistance. iwiDUR is not restricted to the food industry; it is also used in many other sectors, such as medical engineering.




